Volunteer attorneys, accredited representatives, and law students will be available to answer your questions, assist you in applying, and providing study materials so you can become a U.S. citizen.

WHY APPLY NOW?

- Help is here. Free preparation assistance for the application, ESL, and the citizenship exam is available, regardless of income.
- The citizenship application will likely double in length to 21 pages in early 2014!
- Fee waivers are available.
- No more immigration fees as a citizen.
- To vote in 2014
- Because you are likely eligible.

You will need to bring the following documents to the workshop:

- ✓ Your Permanent Resident Card ("green card")
- ✓ Two passport photos (2"x2") of yourself.
- ✓ Your driver's license or state ID card.
- ✓ Your Social Security number
- ✓ If you are married to a U.S. citizen, his/her birth certificate and/or certificate of naturalization if married for less than five years
- ✓ All marriage certificates and divorce records
- ✓ Your children's birth certificates if they are also permanent residents
- ✓ List of residences for the past five years.
- ✓ List of employers/schools for the past five years.
- ✓ A list of every trip you have taken outside the U.S. (including trips to Canada and Mexico).
- ✓ Check or money order for \$680, payable to the Department of Homeland Security, <u>OR</u> you may qualify for a fee waiver. Call to inquire.
