# Did you know that as a U.S. citizen, besides being able to vote and run for elected office, you:

- Are safe(r) from deportation,
- May petition for more family members from abroad,
- Qualify for certain tax credits,
- Can travel for as long as you want outside the country without consequences
- And so much more...

# You will need to bring the following documents to the workshop:

- Your Permanent Resident Card ("green card")
- ✓ Two passport photos (2"x2") of yourself.
- ✓ Your driver's license or state ID card.
- ✓ Your Social Security number
- ✓ If you are married to a U.S. citizen, his/her birth certificate and/or certificate of naturalization if married for less than five years
- ✓ All marriage certificates and divorce records
- ✓ Your children's birth certificates if they are also permanent residents
- ✓ List of residences for the past five years.
- List of employers/schools for the past five years.
- ✓ A list of every trip you have taken outside the U.S. (including trips to Canada and Mexico).
- Check or money order for \$680, payable to the Department of Homeland Security, <u>OR</u> you may qualify for a fee waiver. Call (734) 998-6100 x459 to inquire.
